CALL TO REPENTANCE

We have not always sought to live in Your light. Forgive us. Prince of Peace, we confess that we have not recognized the peace that You have brought to our discordant lives. It does not fill our hearts and minds. Forgive us. Have mercy upon us we pray.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

To us a Child is born; to us God's Son is given! Christ's eternal reign has broken through to our time and place with the brilliant light of His mercy and forgiveness. All your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Arise, shine, for your light has come! And the glory of the Lord has risen upon you!

THE TIME OF PROMISED FULFILLMENT ANNOUNCED

SCRIPTURE READING: Luke 1:26-38

In the sixth month, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary. The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you."

Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. SPREADING THE LIGHT OF CHRIST

Leader: Tonight we celebrate the coming of Christ, the Light of the world. Our candles bear witness to Light, and brighten this time of celebration.

Lighting of the first candle on the Advent Wreath.

People: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and without Him not one thing came into being. (John 1:1-3)

Hymn (#101) "Name of All Majesty" (v. 1)

Name of all majesty, fathomless mystery, King of the ages by angels adored; Power and authority, splendor and dignity, Bow to His mastery – Jesus is Lord!

Leader: By the light of God's creating Word we are led to the brighter light of faith in Him.

Lighting of the second candle on the Advent Wreath.

People: What has come into being in Him was life, and that life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it. (John 1:4-5)

Hymn (#101) "Name of All Majesty" (v. 2)

Child of our destiny, God from eternity, Love of the Father on sinners outpoured; See now what God has done sending His only Son, Christ the beloved One – Jesus is Lord!

Leader: With the coming of God's Son, our Emmanuel, the light shines still more brightly.

Lighting of the third candle on the Advent Wreath.

People: The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world came into being through Him, yet the world did not know Him. He came to what was His own, and His own people did not accept Him. But to all who received Him, who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God. (John 1:9-12)

Hymn (#101) "Name of All Majesty" (v. 3)

Savior of Calvary, costliest victory,
Darkness defeated and Eden restored;
Born as a man to die, nailed to the cross on high,
Cold in the grave to lie – Jesus is Lord!

Leader: The Light of the Lord continues to shine, as it radiates through us filling our lives with Christian love and service; for God has given us His Word.

Lighting of the fourth candle on the Advent Wreath.

People: The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

Hymn (#101) "Name of All Majesty" (v. 4)

Source of all sovereignty, light, immortality, Life everlasting and heaven assured; So with the ransomed, we praise Him eternally, Christ in His majesty – Jesus is Lord! Lighting of the Christ candle, and from it our individual candles.

[The ushers will light the candle of the first person in each row from the center aisle. Then each person will light their candle off the lit candle of the person next to them. Please be sure to tip <u>only</u> the unlit candle to help avoid the dripping of wax.]
