SCRIPTURE READING: Ephesians 4:17-24 (Pew Bible pp. 1821-1822)

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed.

That, however, is not the way of life you learned when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION: (Unison prayer after a time of silent personal confession.)

O Lord, we have sinned times without number, and have been guilty of pride and unbelief, of failure to find Your mind in Your Word, of neglect to seek You in daily life. Our sins present us with a list of accusations, but we bless You that they will not stand against us for all have been laid on Christ. Subdue our corruptions, and grant us grace to live above them. Let not the passions of the flesh nor the lusting of the mind bring our spirits into subjection, but rule over us in liberty and power. Purge us from every false desire, and every base aspiration -- everything contrary to Your rule. Deliver us from every evil habit, every layer of former sins, everything that dims the brightness of Your grace in us, everything that prevents us from taking delight in You. (Adapted from "The Valley of Vision: Puritan Prayers and Devotions")

ASSURANCE OF PARDON (adapted from Romans 5:1-2)

Leader: Since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God – the forgiveness of our sins through the sacrifice of our Savior, Jesus the Christ -- through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. Therefore let us rejoice in the hope of the glory of God – the one true God who offers eternal life to all who come to Him in faith.

***All:** (*Gloria Patri*)

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. Amen.

ENCOUNTERING GOD THROUGH GOD'S WORD

SCRIPTURE READING: Colossians 3:1-10 (Pew Bible p. 1834)

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly

things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

Affirmation of Faith: The Nicene Creed
