PRAYER OF ADORATION/INVOCATION

**O sing a song of Bethlehem, of shepherds watching there,

PRAYER OF CONFESSION: (Unison prayer after a time of silent personal confession.)

God of light, we have been so blind when truth has been so clear. Instead of looking at our world with the eyes of Christ, we have chosen to see things from our own narrow perspective, and have responded to the needs of our world out of self-interest. Instead of seeking to discern the Spirit's leading, we have been more attuned to our wants, and have missed Your way. Forgive our failure to follow in the path of love's clear leading. Give us faith that trusts when it cannot see. And enable us to be guided by the Light that is Christ, Who is the bright Morning Star, and through Whom we can be that light to our world that You call us to be.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON:

Leader: There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life sets us free from the law of sin and death. And if the Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead lives in us, God who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to our mortal bodies through the Spirit, who lives in us. Therefore, I declare to you in the name of Jesus Christ: You are forgiven!

ENCOUNTERING GOD THROUGH GOD'S WORD

SCRIPTURE READING: Isaiah 42:5-13 (Pew Bible pp. 1124-1125)

This is what God the LORD says –
the Creator of the heavens, who stretches them out,
 who spreads out the earth with all that springs from it,
 who gives breath to its people,
 and life to those who walk on it:
“I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness;
 I will take hold of your hand.
I will keep you and will make you
 to be a covenant for the people
 and a light for the Gentiles,
to open eyes that are blind,
 to free captives from prison
 and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness.

“I am the LORD; that is my name!
 I will not yield my glory to another
 or my praise to idols.

See, the former things have taken place,

Affirmation of Faith: The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through Him all things were made. For us and for our salvation He came down from heaven, was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary and became truly human.
